

In 1961, Russ Mulroy, a 6'1" guard from Levittown Memorial, had a 3 game scoring streak that ranks among the best in Long Island history.

Against Lawrence, he rang up 46 points and followed that with a 41 point outburst against Long Beach. He finally "slowed down" with 33 points against South Side.

During this stretch, he converted 38 of 43 field goal attempts (88%) and all 44 of his free throws on his way to making 76 in a row.
